

MINUTES of the ORTHODONTIC RESEARCH GROUP at IADR

MEETING HELD MONDAY APRIL 24TH, at the SPRING HILL SUITES HOTEL, SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA

1.Welcome

4.1 Planning for the London Meeting, England - July 25-28, 2018

 - Accelerated tooth movement
 - Growth and development topics
 - Non-surgical treatment of severe cases
 - Bone stimulation
- 30 minutes per presentation, 3 speakers

4.2.4 Hands-On Workshops

- Our field lends itself for real HOW experiences
- 10-100 attendees per HOW

4.2.5 Lunch & Learn

- Will be held in different languages depending on speaker's country and interest
- Each region will prepare a short talk about a topic of interest to their own region and will be presented by one member of the region.

- Can accommodate only 9 attendees per event

- It was suggested by members that we start a marketing campaign to inform world Orthodontists of the existence of this new group. These activities should include:
 - Translating and distributing the ORG Newsletter in each country
 - Advertising in each country's Orthodontic Association
 - Contacting universities and Orthodontics programs worldwide
 - Advertise in electronic media, such as the AADR and IADR Bulletin, NIDCR News and other online magazines that do not charge for advertising
 - We are drafting letters that each country representative can translate and use in their country ORG promotion activities
